

## **FLOWER BLOCK B**

Templates for Flower Block B have been already reversed for Fusible Web Appliqué.

You will need to make two Flower Block B blocks. Print out templates making sure “Actual Size” option is checked in the drop-down box before printing.

When printing is completed, tape the two pages together that form the long stem. You will need to trim one edge off one of the pages that has the long stem on it, once it is trimmed, just line up the two pages so all stem lines align, and tape in place. You are now ready to trace the templates onto the paper side of the fusible web.

\*When tracing the Large Stem template, it is very important to extend the solid black line out to the edge of the dashed ¼” line on each end of the stem. This is so you will have enough fabric on each end to be caught up in your seam allowance when you sew the blocks together.

## **FLOWER BLOCK C**

Templates for Flower Block C have not been reversed for Fusible Web Appliqué.

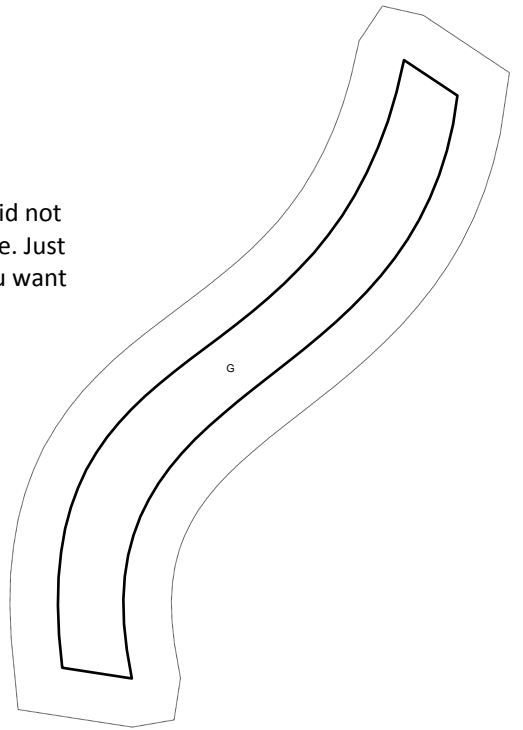
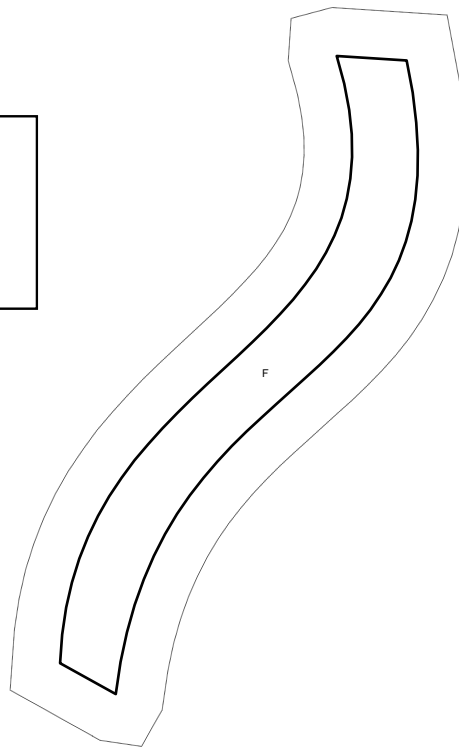
Make two Flower Block C’s using the templates from Flower Block B.

VERY IMPORTANT! To get the correct C templates you will need to REVERSE the B templates using either a light box or by taping the templates for Block B so that the front of the pages are facing the window or light source. Make sure the C templates are facing the same direction as shown in the Layout Sheet for Block C.

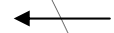
## **FLOWER BLOCK B & C Options**

You may decide to have all the Flower Block B’s and Flower Block C’s exactly the same. If that is the case, then simply make 4 Flower Block B’s and call it good! Play around with the placement of the designs and see if you like a different layout. This is your quilt! Have fun!

ends.



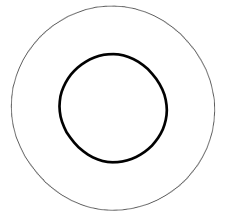
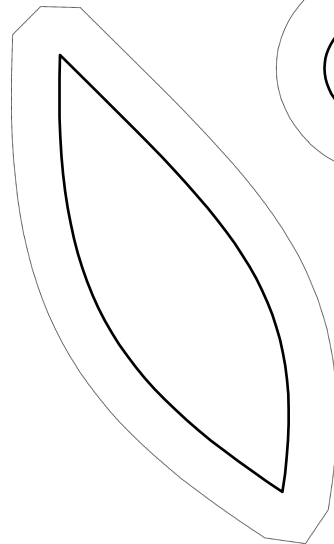
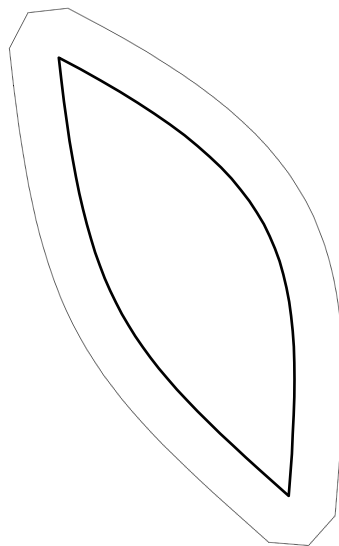
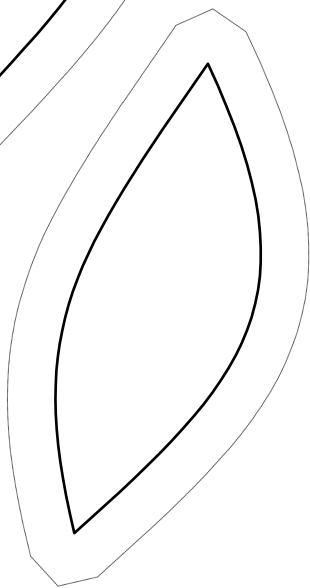
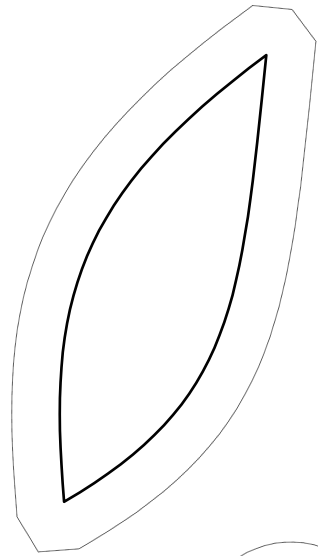
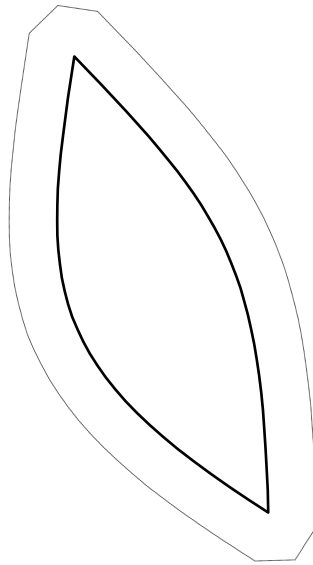
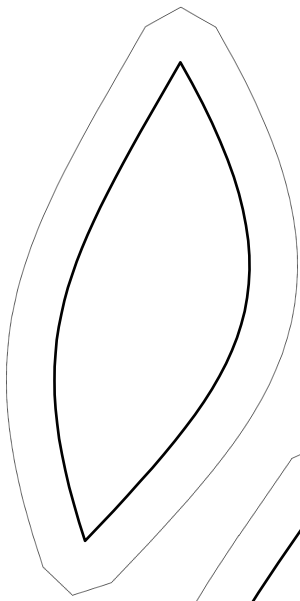
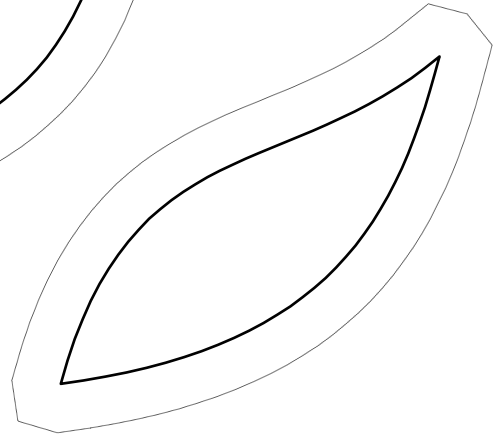
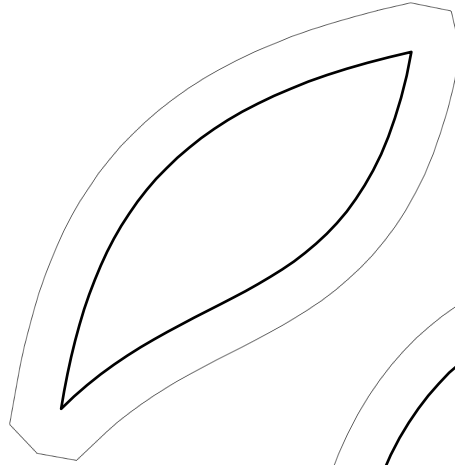
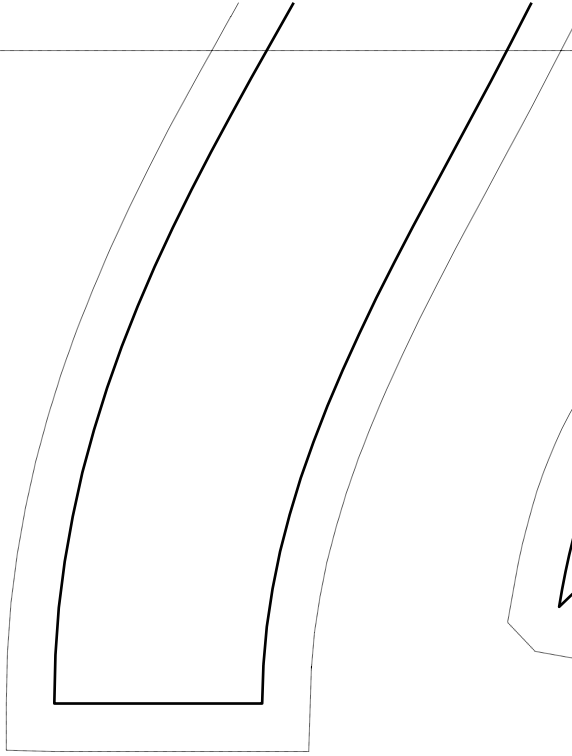
The Large Stem and both Short Stems are to be cut  
from color 1. Trace on solid lines for fusible web. Once  
you have ironed the traced templates to the **BACK SIDE**  
of your fabric, cut pieces out on solid lines.

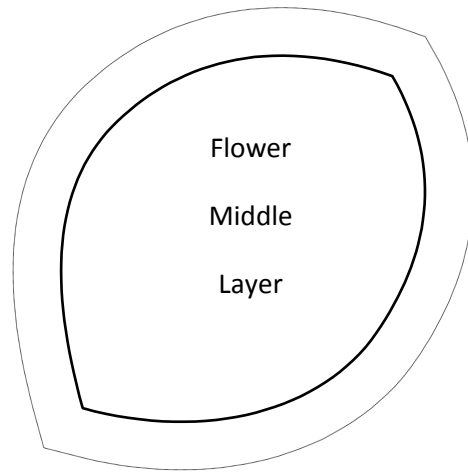
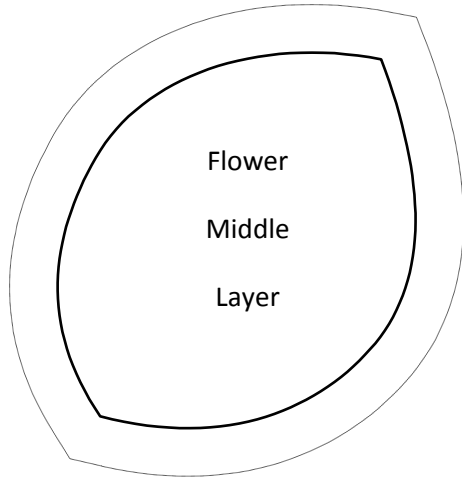
**Very Important:** When tracing Large Stem please  
extend the **solid line** out to the dashed line at each end  
of the stem or your stems will not be long enough to be  
caught up in the 1/4" seam allowance when you sew the  
blocks together.

After tracing flower shapes onto paper side of fusible webbing, iron to back of desired fabrics for each piece. Cut on solid line. Center a Top Layer over each Middle Layer and iron in place. Then center and iron each of the top/middle layers across the widest area of the Flower Bottom Layer so there is equal spacing on either side of the center unit which will form your flowers.
